Plaintiff A written law that is created by

the government

Defense Attorney A person who tells the jury what he/she

knows about the case

Prosecuting Attorney The person accused of a crime

interprets the law if needed

Verdict A person who starts a lawsuit in a civil case

Jury The lawyer who represents the defendant

Voir Dire The decision by the Jury
